#### 1. License for Institutional Access

Subject to acceptance of the terms and conditions of this agreement and upon verification of the information on the Registration Form and payment of the annual subscription fee, Columbia University Press grants to the licensed Institution a one-year or three-year, as applicable, non-transferable license to access all materials included in the Columbia Granger's® World of Poetry Online. An authorized signature on this agreement indicates that the Institution has accepted the terms of this license. This license grants access to the Internet domain (range, or ranges, of IP addresses) of the Institution or Institutions as specified on the Registration Form. This basic license will allow an authorized user from an authorized IP address to have access to Columbia Granger's® World of Poetry Online. This expanded license also grants access to authenticated users who have a valid user name and password; control over authentication of users and use of names and passwords is

the responsibility of the Institution offering this service. The Institution is responsible for undertaking reasonable measures to prevent access by unauthorized or unauthenticated persons to its IP addresses, and the Institution will be responsible for unauthorized access except as specified below. 
